


OVERALL ACTIONS

- •All state & national: 322,685
- •Lame duck messages: 50,969
- •53,860 petition signatures on our research campaign
- •LSLD Meetings: 376 House offices, including 83 member-level meetings and 142 senior staff-level meetings





- •567 Cancer Votes Ambassadors across 48 states, D.C., and Puerto Rico
- •42,000 online actions
- •16,000 messages sent to candidates asking them to sign the Cancer Promise
- •93 candidates signed the Cancer Promise



Cancer Votes

- •16 coffee chats with key U.S. Senate and U.S. House candidates
- •Radio voter guide in Montana featuring responses to our Cancer Votes questionnaire from U.S. Senate candidates reaching over 32,000 listeners
- •221 voters registered, 406 voters verified, and initiated 919 ballot lookups
- •27 media clips
