

Frequent Questions about Cancer Action Day



Ohio Cancer Action Day 2022

Q: If I'm the only participant from my district, will I be on my own to talk with my lawmaker or staff member?

A: No, every volunteer is assigned a mentor, so no one goes alone to a meeting

Q: Do I have to stay all day?

A: No, there is some flexibility and if your meetings are finished you can head out for the day. We will have a drawing for the prize packet if you complete the scavenger hunt between 2:30 and 3:00pm. You must be present to win (unless in a lawmaker meeting). Otherwise, you can leave after your last meeting.

Q: Do I need to attend the Q&A session if I have no questions?

A: Yes. sometimes you don't know you have a question until someone else asks it, but we will also have lots of good information about CAD to share.

Q: What should I wear to Cancer Action Day if I do not have any ACS CAN clothing. Can I wear my ACS Relay For Life gear? (Or items for/against a current or past elected official, graphic t-shirts, etc., etc.)

A: The dress code for CAD is business casual. This is an ACS CAN event and we request you don't wear an ACS branded shirt or any graphic t-shirt or campaign shirt. As a nonpartisan organization, we do not wear political clothing or other support or opposition for elected officials. You will be doing quite a bit of walking so wear comfortable shoes and be prepared for the weather in Columbus.

Q Does it cost anything

A: We will provide meals and beverages during the day. If you would like to supplement those meals that is on your own. There is a fee to park downtown but you will be provided with a volunteer reimbursement form in your folder to submit for reimbursement for those costs.
