With the start of the 119<sup>th</sup> Congress, we need to get our priorities in front of lawmakers and continue advocating for evidence-based public policies to reduce the cancer burden for everyone.

During January recess, the week of January 27<sup>th</sup>, we ask that you:

- Print out and <u>add your contact information</u> to the attached packet
- Visit your House and Senate offices and drop off the packet
- At your visits take a selfie and use the following language to post to social media
  - Just stopped by [insert lawmaker handle] district office to drop off @ACSCAN materials that highlight our #CancerAdvocacy priorities for the First 100 Days of the 119th Congress. Will you meet with us to discuss how public policies can save lives from cancer? [attach photo from the drop off]
  - We need [insert lawmaker handle] & other lawmakers to prioritize cancer research, protect Medicaid, & increase access to early detection. That's why I joined @ACSCAN volunteers to drop off materials at their district office. Please meet with us to discuss these critical issues. [attach photo from drop off]
- Be sure to get the business cards of staff at the offices. After the visits send an email to the staff asking for meetings during February recess (week of February 17<sup>th</sup>). Our goal is to meet with as many House and Senate offices as we can.
- Use the report back form to let ACS CAN know that you took action
