With the start of the 119th Congress, we need to get our priorities in front of lawmakers and continue advocating for evidence-based public policies to reduce the cancer burden for everyone.

During January recess, the week of January 27th, we ask that you:

- Print out and add your contact information to the attached packet
- Visit your House and Senate offices and drop off the packet
- At your visits take a selfie and use the following language to post to social media
 - Just stopped by [insert lawmaker handle] district office to drop off @ACSCAN materials that highlight our #CancerAdvocacy priorities for the First 100 Days of the 119th Congress. Will you meet with us to discuss how public policies can save lives from cancer? [attach photo from the drop off]
 - We need [insert lawmaker handle] & other lawmakers to prioritize cancer research, protect Medicaid, & increase access to early detection. That's why I joined @ACSCAN volunteers to drop off materials at their district office. Please meet with us to discuss these critical issues. [attach photo from drop off]
- Be sure to get the business cards of staff at the offices. After the visits send an email to the staff asking for meetings during February recess (week of February 17th). Our goal is to meet with as many House and Senate offices as we can.
- Use the report back form to let ACS CAN know that you took action
