Did You Know...

- 27.6% of cancer deaths in Montana are caused by smoking.
- Almost half of Montana youth have tried e-cigarettes, and 26% of Montana youth currently use them.²
- More than 1,600 Montanans die each year from tobaccorelated disease.³
- Montanans spend more than \$511 million every year due to smoking-related health care costs.⁴
- 92% of Montana voters support continuing to use revenue from the Master Settlement to fund tobacco prevention programs.⁵
- A well-funded fact-based tobacco control program is needed to counteract the \$29.1 million per year that tobacco companies are spending to market their deadly and addictive products in Montana.⁶
